Criteria for Oregon Fairs Association Education Fund Sponsorship

- 1. Applications must be submitted by the youth (individual or group) requesting the funding.
- 2. No one group or individual may submit an application two consecutive years.
- 3. Applications must be submitted and received by OFA 45 days prior to the competition or training session to allow the OFA Board time to evaluate and reach a decision.
- 4. \$500 is the maximum amount of sponsorship.
- 5. A written evaluation or report of the function must be submitted within 30 days following the function.
